Thank You for registering to camp at the fair this year. Please find included your parking permits with your assigned campsite number written on the permit. **This tag must be visibly displayed in your vehicle to use the camping drive and to park in the camping area.** Any vehicles without a tag will be subject to towing. You may set up your camper anytime starting Sunday, June 16th through Sunday, June 23rd. You can connect to power for setup and to run your refrigerator but you cannot have your A/C running until Saturday, June 22nd. Your camper needs to be removed by Tuesday, July 2nd. Any violations will be subject to additional charges.

Camp fires are allowed this year. You must use an enclosed fire pit and it must sit at least 8 inches off the ground. No fire is to be left unattended and keep the blaze under control. Please have a fire extinguisher on hand in event any mishaps were to happen.

If you're camping along the pine tree line then your campsite is to the east of the water and power hook ups. Meaning the water and power hook up will be located on the back left corner of you camper. Other camping locations will be marked out for proper camper location.
